


"If we have a coordinated system for linking families to services, they can spend less time navigating multiple systems and more time helping their children grow and thrive."

Help Me Grow simplifies the landscape.



- Maximizes existing services




Families get the right resources at the right times.






Help Me Grow is a National Model

- The Washington State affiliate is WithinReach.






National Help Me Grow System Components






Washington Help Me Grow System Components







Leadership Structure of Help Me Grow Washington




Core Team: supports the entire HMG Washington Structure






Action Team Members' Responsibilities

| Lead | Lead for equity, diversity and inclusion in an effort to ensure all facets of the Help Me Grow system are advancing equity and focused on eliminating racial and ethnic disparities for children and families. | |

| Active Participation | Attend majority of meetings, review meeting materials, and come prepared. | |
| Think Systems | Discuss and actively consider the broader cross-system needs and interests, informed by your own organization/stakeholder/community perspectives. | |
| HMG Champion & Liaison | Champion Help Me Grow Washington by fostering interest, passion and excitement across network. Update your organizations/stakeholders/community groups on the status of this work, and report back to the Action Team on comments and reactions to draft products and/or co-design products. | |
| Shared Decision-Making | Work with other members to find consensus on Action Team recommendations. Lead with curiosity and ask questions of one another to better understand each other's opinions and perspectives. | |

- As an Action Team member, what would you hope to accomplish between now and January?




